
Make you own birch-bark canoe!!



- 1. Cut out both designs along the dotted lines.
- 2. To start folding the canoe, orient the paper so that the design faces up and the ribs are vertical.
- 3. Turn paper over, fold it in half, crease, and unfold.
- 4. Fold top and bottom edges to the crease made in previous step.
- 5. Fold the gunwales in half along the dark line so that one half of each gunnel folds over the bark on the flip side.
- 6. Fold in half along the crease made in step 3.
- 7. Turn the folded paper so that the side *without* the canoe logo is facing up.

- 8. Fold up the corners so that they tuck under the folded gunwales, and the logo appears on the bow.
- 9. Open up the canoe and shape it into form.
- 10. Now, for the stand. With text facing **down**, fold the paper in half.
- 11. With text facing **up**, fold paper in half again.
- 12. On both sides, fold paper back along dotted line.
- 13. Crease all folds, and then let paper naturally spread so that it lies on the table with text facing up.
- 14. Place the stern of the canoe in the creased fold, and display proudly.
